TREE PROTECTION NOTES

INSTALL 1800mm TALL CONTINUOUS CHAIN MESH FENCE SUPPORTED BY 2400mm TALL STAR STEEL POSTS TO ISOLATE CONSTRUCTION SITE WORKS AND VERGES AS SHOWN ON

ALL FENCING TO BE ERECTED ON COMMENCEMENT OF SITE WORK AND REMOVED AT COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION. THE FENCE IS TO REMAIN CONTINUOUS THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT, EXCEPT WHERE APPROVED SERVICE INSTALLATION OCCURS.

EXCAVATE WITH EXTREME CARE WITHIN TREE PROTECTION ZONES (CANOPY + 2m) EXPOSE ROOTS AND CUT ALL ROOTS >50mm DIA BY HAND SAW.

ALL EXPOSED ROOTS ARE TO BE KEPT DAMP (THROUGH WRAPPING IN WET HESSIAN OR SIMILAR) AND BACKFILLED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

ANY PRUNING TO REMOVE BRANCHES TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH AUSTRALIAN STANDARD 4373 'PRUNING OF AMENITY TREES'.

ALL WORK IS TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MITS 09 DRYLAND GRASSING AND TOPSOIL. MAKE GOOD ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING VERGES REINSTATE AS PER THE MITS.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BUILDER TO ENSURE THAT ANY DISTURBANCES TO THE VERGE, TREES, PATHS, KERBS, ROADWAYS OR SERVICES OCCURING FROM EITHER CONSTRUCTION WORKS OR STORAGE OF MACHINERY/MATERIALS DURING THE

CONSTRUCTION. WORKS ARE RECTIFIED TO THE SATISFACTION OF RELEVANT AUTHORITIES.




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BIRCH ROOT CONDITION
