The time allowed for public consultation on this Works Application in the run-up to Christmas is very short!

- 2. I would like to flag the importance of Wendouree Drive to cyclists and pedestrians as a way for safe access under the heavy traffic in Parkes Way in getting to and from Lake Burley Griffin and its commuter routes. The footpath along the opposite side of Wendouree Drive to the Anzac Park East redevelopment, outside the ASIO headquarters, is an unfortunate example of how not to provide for cyclists and pedestrians. It is narrow, with multiple motor vehicle entrances to the site, with sloping tactile surfaces! It is a danger at times when heavily used by pedestrians, joggers, dog-walkers, pram-pushers, cyclists of various abilities, and riders on e-scooters.
- 3. Quite a different approach must be taken on the edge of the Anzac Park East site. It must have a footpath of considerable width (ideally separating pedestrians and cyclists), with good sightlines, and motor vehicles having to give way to cyclists and pedestrians. The much greater intensity of the development of the site by the Works Application proposal compared to the previous Anzac Park East building means that motor traffic on Wendouree Drive is likely to increase greatly.
- 4. I look forward to seeing that project approvals take proper account of the interests of local residents, Canberra residents at large, and visitors to Canberra.
- 5. I reserve the right to submit further comments after more study of the documentation.
