



Flag policy – Kings Avenue

Preamble

The National Capital Authority (NCA) is responsible for managing and promoting the National Triangle. The area is home to a range of national cultural institutions and commemorative sites that tell national stories.

One way of telling the national story, or commemorating significant occasions is through displaying flags along ANZAC Parade, Federation Mall, Russell flyover, and Kings Avenue.

This policy sets out the criteria and approval process for requesting flags to be flown on the flag poles at Kings Avenue.

The policy is subject to periodic review and may be updated as required.

Criteria for Approval

Flag requests will only be considered if they meet one of the following criteria:

1. Commemorative Occasions:
 - Public celebrations and commemorations of national significance: such as national days, historic anniversaries, or nationally recognised civic milestones.
 - Guest of Government visits and ceremonial occasions organised by the Australian government.
2. Promotion of non-political, registered national charitable awareness campaigns.
3. Promotion of events hosted by ACT Government or Australian Government entities (including Cultural Institutions)

Flag requests will not be considered for:

- Commercial purposes (e.g. Advertising)
- Personal occasions (e.g. Weddings, birthdays, engagements, memorials).
- Religious observances

All requests involving foreign governments and/or foreign related events will be referred to the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) for consideration and approval.

Multiyear applications are not available—new applications must be submitted each year.
