

RACE REGISTRATION TERMS (The Terms)

1. I acknowledge that it is a condition of my participation in the kayak race called the Lake Burley Griffin Challenge Cup 2018 to be held on 19 October 2018 (the Race), and use of the provided equipment, that I make the following representations and warranties and I hereby do so.
2. In these Terms, participation means my involvement in the Race, including preparation, activity and finishing of the Race.
3. In these Terms, equipment means the items provided for the participation in the Race, including, but not limited to, kayaks, paddles, and personal floatation devices.

RULES

4. I have read, understood and agree to be bound by the attached Lake Burley Griffin Challenge Cup Safety Rules as a condition of my participation in the Race.

RISK AND CAPACITY TO PARTICIPATE

5. I acknowledge that participation in the Race will involve physical activity and that this activity involves inherent risks that may result in any manner of harm, loss, damage, injury and even death, to me or to others.
6. I acknowledge that the National Capital Authority (NCA) undertakes water quality monitoring of Lake Burley Griffin and will provide advice on the suitability of the water quality for the event and will provide advice concerning associated risks. After receiving this information, should I participate in the Race it is at my own risk.
7. The risks of using kayaks and racing while using kayaks may result in harm to myself and/or others including, but not limited to: drowning, cuts, blisters, muscle strains, joint soreness or injury, hypothermia, sun stroke, and illness caused by exposure to bacteria and/ or blue green algae.
8. I warrant that:
 - a. I am aware of the inherent and extrinsic risk to my health, life and property in participating in the Race and agree that I do so at my own risk;
 - b. I am physically capable of participating in the race and using the equipment;
 - c. I will comply with any advice, instructions or directions given by the NCA, the Water Police or AMTL Events while participating in, preparing for or finishing the Race;
9. I agree to assume all responsibility for any personal injury or death to myself or others resulting from, or arising out of, my use of the equipment, being the kayak, personal floatation device (PFD) and paddle and any other item provided for use in connection to the Race.

RELEASE OF THE NCA, THE WATER POLICE AND AMTL Events

10. I agree to waive, release and discharge forever the NCA, the Water Police and AMTL Events in relation to any personal injury, illness, or death to myself or otherwise resulting from, or arising out of, my participation in the Race ('the Waiver').

11. Without limiting the operation of the Waiver, I acknowledge and agree that the Waiver shall extend to any personal injury, illness, or death to myself caused by:
 - a. The negligence, action or inaction of the NCA, the Water Police or AMTL Events or participants or persons present at, the Race;
 - b. My own negligence, action or inaction; and
 - c. My failure to follow the advice or instructions of the NCA, Water Police or AMTL Events concerning my participation in the Race.
12. I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the NCA, the Water Police and AMTL Events from and against any claim, cause of action, liability or judgement resulting from, or arising out of, or in connection with my participation in the Race to which the waivers in Clauses 10 and 11 apply.
13. I agree to indemnify the NCA, the Water Police and AMTL Events from any damage caused by me to the personal and real property of AMTL Events or to the personal property of other participants of the Race.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT TO BEAR MEDICAL AND TREATMENT COSTS

14. I acknowledge that individual personal accident insurance is not included in my participation in the Race. In the event of injury, accident or illness, I consent to receiving initial first aid treatment (if the attending first aid officer consider it appropriate) and paying all costs associated with ambulance transportation (if required), and ongoing medical treatment as required.

MISSING AND DAMAGED EQUIPMENT

15. I agree to pay for the repair or replacement of any AMTL Events property damaged, or lost, by me.

TRUE AND CORRECT INFORMATION

16. I acknowledge that the information given on this form, or otherwise provided by me is true and correct.
17. My online registration and the online registration of my team is our acknowledgement and acceptance of these Terms.

LAKE BURLEY GRIFFIN CHALLENGE CUP SAFETY RULES

For your safety and the safety of others you are required to follow these rules:

1. Participants must comply with any advice, instructions or directions of the NCA, the Water Police or AMTL Events.
2. Participants must wear the provided Personal Floatation Device at all times when on, or near the water.
3. People affected by alcohol or illicit drugs will not be permitted to participate in the Race.
4. No un-sportsman like behaviour.
5. Be aware of your surroundings.
6. Participants must notify the first aid station of any injury or incident resulting in harm or damage.
