

MAKE YOUR OWN CARILLON BELLS

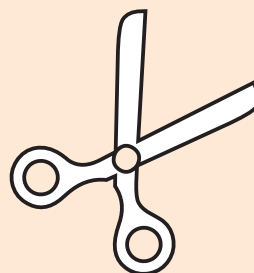
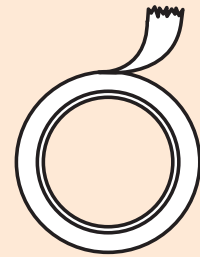
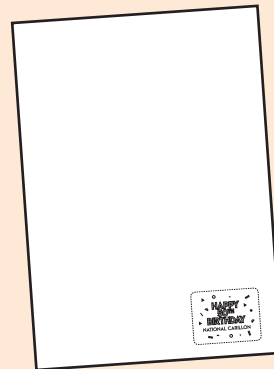
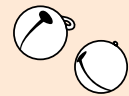
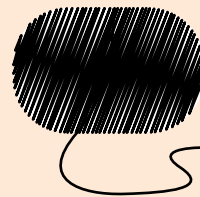
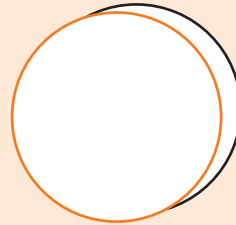


MATERIALS

You will need:

- Thin cardboard cut into circles of 20cm diameter. You could even use old sheet music.
- 2 small bells (minimum)
- Wool - to thread the bells onto.
- Sticky tape
- 'Happy 50th Birthday National Carillon' cut-out (see below)
- Scissors
- Felt-tip marker

INSTRUCTIONS

1

Decorate the paper circles you have cut and the Happy Birthday image before you start construction.

2

Tape one of the pieces of wool with a bell attached to the edge of one of the circles. It should hang down the middle of the circle.

3

Roll the edges of the circle together to create a cone. Tape the overlapping edges together.

4

Repeat the previous two steps so you have two bells. Tape the bells together.

5

Cut out the Happy Birthday image and tape it to the top of the bells.


6

Tape a piece of wool in a loop to the top of the Happy Birthday image so it creates a handle. You may want to use several pieces of wool and plait them to make it thicker.

7
