

**MAKE YOUR OWN**

# Bogong Moths



*This activity involves cutting, so ask an adult for help*

## Materials

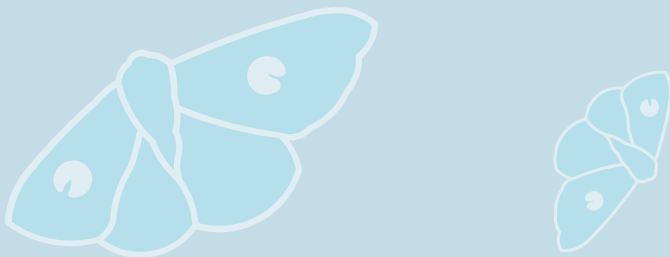
- Empty toilet roll
- Brown felt
- Coloured paper or cardboard to make wings
- Feathers or pipe cleaners for antennae
- Extra supplies to decorate your wings, eg coloured pencils or crayons
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue or a stapler
- Sticky tape



## Instructions

- 1 Ask an adult to draw and cut out two egg shapes, roughly the length of the toilet paper roll. These are the moth's wings.
- 2 Decorate the wings. You could cut out shapes from paper and stick them on the wings, or use pencils or crayons.
- 3 Cut out a rectangle of brown felt and wrap it around the toilet paper roll. Stick it on using glue, sticky tape, or staples.
- 4 Tape or staple the wings to the back of your moth.
- 5 Fold the pipe cleaner in half. Sticky tape the fold to the inside of the top of the toilet paper roll. You could also use feathers to make the antennae.
