Tree collage





This activity involves cutting, so ask an adult for help

- Scissors
- Tree template (see page 3)
- Felt tip pens or coloured pencils
- A mix of things to stick on your tree – we used real autumn leaves that we collected from outside, but you could use wrapping paper, fabric, etc.

Instructions

- Ask an adult to download, print, and cut out your tree template at the end of this document.
- Colour it in with pencils or felt tip pens and glue it onto your sheet of A3 paper.
- Go for a walk with your family to your local park and collect lots of beautiful leaves to glue onto your artwork. How many different colours can you find?
- When you get back home, glue the leaves to your tree. You can also ask an adult to cut out some other leaf shapes out of other materials for you to add.
- Display your artwork by sticking it to a window so when the trees outside have dropped all their leaves you have your colourful tree to keep looking at.


