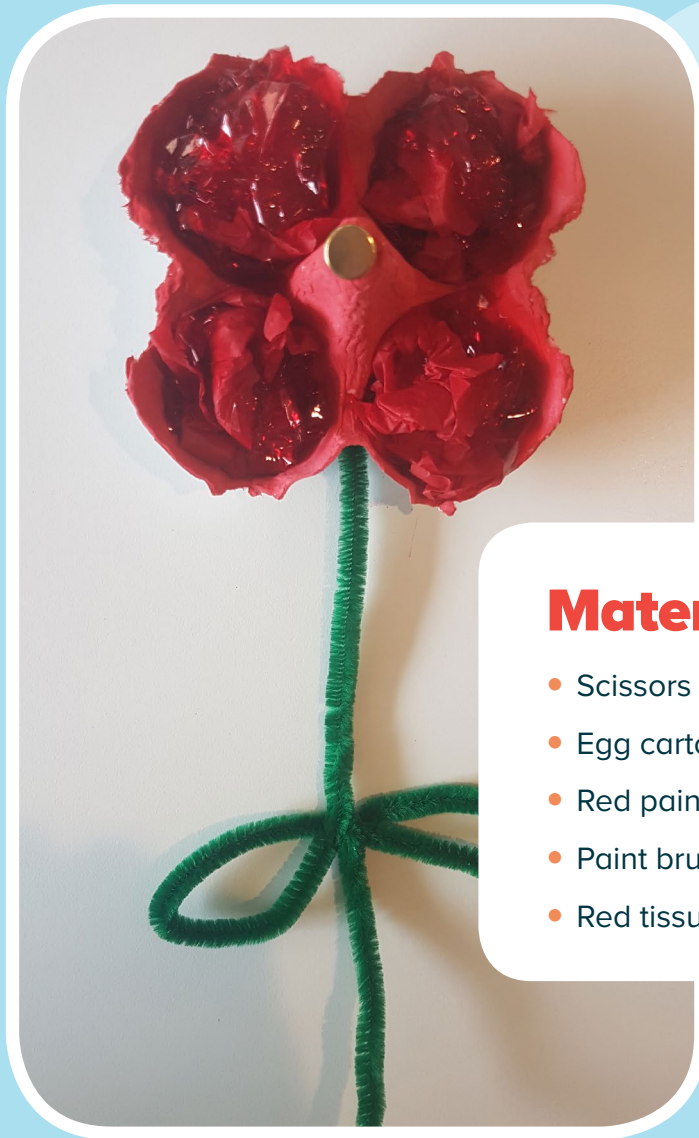


MAKE YOUR OWN

Roses

little
griffins



Materials

- Scissors
- Egg carton
- Red paint
- Paint brush
- Red tissue paper
- Red cellophane
- Glue
- 1 yellow or gold button
- 2 green pipe cleaners
- Sticky tape



*This activity
involves cutting.
Ask an adult
for help.*



Instructions

1 Ask a grown up to cut out 4 sections of the egg carton, as in the picture. This will form the petals of the flower.

2 Paint the egg carton whatever colour you would like your rose to be – we've used red, but you could use pink, yellow, or another colour.

3 Put the painted egg carton somewhere safe so the paint can dry.

4 Once the paint has dried, ask a grown up to cut out 4 pieces of tissue paper and cellophane. Scrunch up a piece of the tissue paper and cellophane together. Dab a bit of glue inside each egg carton petal and place the tissue paper and cellophane ball in the petal. Repeat so each petal has a ball of tissue paper and cellophane in it.




5 Glue the button in the centre of your flower.

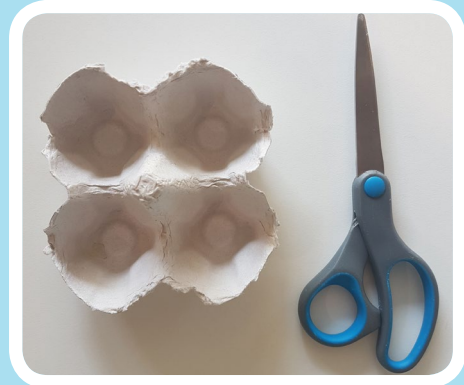
6 Twist one of the pipe cleaners into leaf shapes. Twist this around the second pipe cleaner, which will be the stem of the rose.

7 Use sticky tape to stick the top of the stem to the back of the petals.

Why not try making a garden full of flowers of different colours?
