



MAKE YOUR OWN
Handprint
Swans



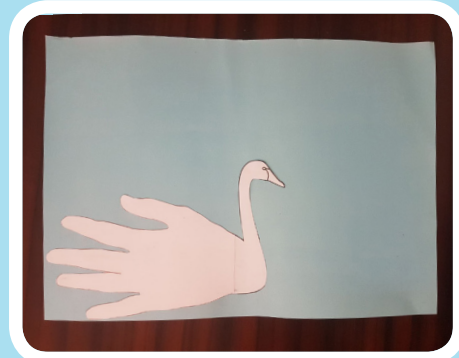
***This activity

Materials



- Swan neck template (see page 3)
- 1 sheet of A3 paper
- 1 sheet of A4 paper
- Scissors
- Black crepe paper
- White cotton wool balls
- Coloured pencils
- Glue

Instructions

- 1 Ask a grown up to help you trace around the outline of one of your hands and cut this out.
- 2 Ask your grown up to cut out the swan neck template. Make sure it is the right size for your hand cut out – the hand will be the swan's body.
- 3 Glue the hand print and swan neck to the A3 paper, leaving room for a second swan. Make sure the thumb faces the top of the paper.
- 4 Scrunch up little pieces of black crepe paper and glue these to your swan's body and neck.
- 5 Colour in the bill using a red pencil.
- 6 Repeat steps 1 – 3.
- 7 Glue the cotton wool balls onto your second swan.
- 8 Decorate the background of the A3 paper to make a lake.

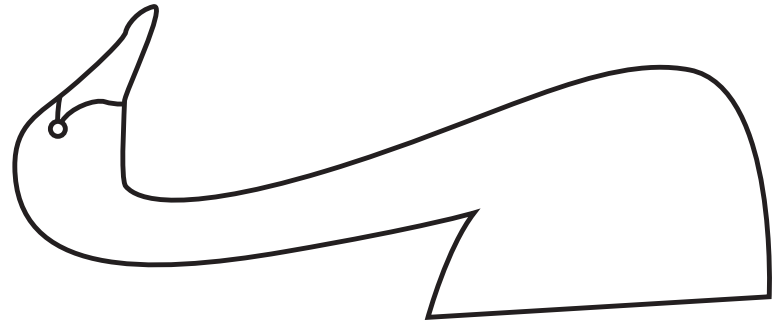
