## MAKE YOUR OWN Handprint Swans





This activity involves cutting.

Ask an adult for help.

- Swan neck template (see page 3)
- 1 sheet of A3 paper
- 1 sheet of A4 paper
- Scissors

- Black crepe paper
- White cotton wool balls
- Coloured pencils
- Glue

## **Instructions**

- Ask a grown up to help you trace around the outline of one of your hands and cut this out.
- Ask your grown up to cut out the swan neck template. Make sure it is the right size for your hand cut out the hand will be the swan's body.
- Glue the hand print and swan neck to the A3 paper, leaving room for a second swan. Make sure the thumb faces the top of the paper.
- Scrunch up little pieces of black crepe paper and glue these to your swan's body and neck.
- Colour in the bill using a red pencil.
  - Repeat steps 1-3.
- Glue the cotton wool balls onto your second swan.
- Decorate the background of the A3 paper to make a lake.
