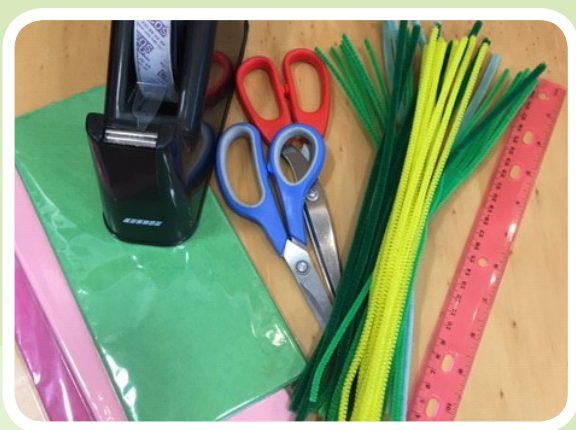


PAPER FLOWERS

Make as many flowers as you like for a creative bouquet or flower centrepiece for the table. Attach our gorgeous flower to your hairclip and wear in your hair as a fun fashion accessory.

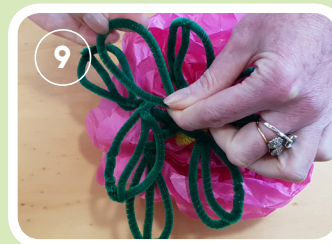
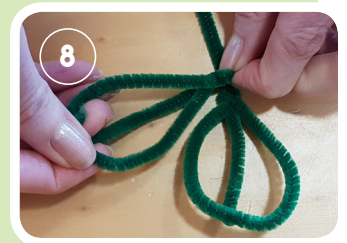
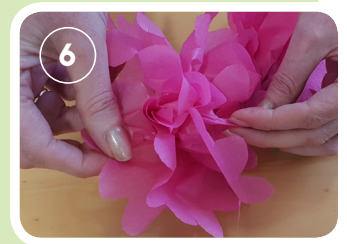
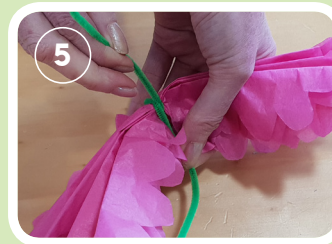
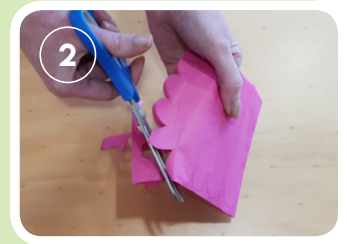
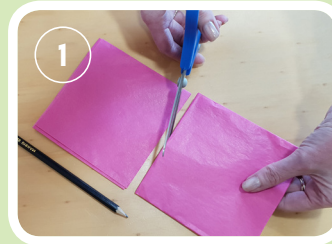
You will need:

- 1 packet each of yellow and green pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- 1 pencil
- Ruler
- Coloured tissue paper




INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Cut a 15 cm square from your roll of tissue paper. Use the corner fold of the tissue paper as your 2 edges.
- 2 The 2 open edges of the square should be facing away and the folded corner shape pointing towards you. Cut a flower petal shape around the 2 open edges of the tissue square.
- 3 Open out your tissue paper square. You should have a frill like pattern around all the edges of your square.
- 4 Fold your square into a fan; folding over one way and then the other. Find the centre point on your fan.
- 5 Tie a green pipe cleaner around your fan at the centre point.
- 6 Separate the layers of tissue paper and your flower petals will start to emerge.
- 7 Twist yellow pipe cleaners around your finger and attach to the green pipe cleaner at centre of the flower.
- 8 Using the green pipe cleaners, loop and twist until they resemble leaves.
- 9 Attach leaves underneath to green pipe cleaner at centre. The more leaves you add the more intricate your flower will become.
- 10 With final shaping your flower is ready to be admired.
